# How to Answer for your Faith in the Court of Law

## Q. How to answer for your faith in the Court of Law?

A. By using this method which is based on two important principles:

### 1. Cross-Referencing

“Whom shall he teach knowledge? and whom shall he make to understand doctrine?... The word of the LORD was unto them **precept upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, and there a little.**” Isaiah 28:9, 10, 13.

### 2. Enunciation and Illustration

“God teaches by the **enunciation** of principles, or universal laws [Isaiah 28:9-11], and the Holy Spirit which comes by faith enlightens the senses that they may grasp the **illustration** of these laws in the physical world. That is heaven's method of teaching the angelic throng, and it was the method applied before the fall.” Living Fountains or Broken Cisterns, 59, E. A Sutherland

## What is the primary purpose of calendation?

- ❑ Although calendars have been used throughout history for economic, agricultural, social or political reasons, the main purpose for creating calendars was and is still today for **religious reasons**: to **worship** God or gods at **appointed times!**
- ❑ The calendar you use represents the God/gods you serve whether you like it or not.
- ❑ This is why there are so many calendars throughout history and in the world today. This is why there are many so-called Biblical Calendars among those who believe in the Torah and the Bible.

## Biblical Calendar on Trial

“He who rules over the calendar  
rules over the nations”

**“For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the Light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.”  
2 Corinthians 4:6**

❑ The only way to identify a genuine diamond is by knowing its properties:  
**Reflection - Refraction – Dispersion** – “Light is parted.” Job 38:24

- ❑ **Reflection** is the light that hits the diamond at the top and is immediately bounced back up, giving it an instantaneous shine. While this glimmer is impressive, it is only the very tip of the true radiance a diamond displays.
- ❑ Only a portion of the light is reflected; the rest travels through it and is scattered and fractured, creating the sparkle that diamonds are known for. This is **Refraction**.
- ❑ Then the light is being aimed back towards the top and out through the surface. This creates a **rainbow effect** and adds to the shine. This is **Dispersion**.

## Biblical Calendar:

### Enunciated Universal Laws Illustrated by Physical Laws

1. “In the beginning **God created** the heaven and the earth.” Genesis 1:1

- God Created** – First Divine Action
- Beginning is **Time** – illustrated with **Astronomy**
- Heaven is **Space** – illustrated with **Astrophysics**
- Earth is **Matter** – illustrated with **Chemistry**
- And **Mathematics**

2. God created the **Group of 7 days** or **Hebdomad** in Genesis 1, 2 – He called the 7<sup>th</sup> day **Sabbath** for the first time in Exodus 16 and 20

- “And the **evening** and the **morning** were the first day.” repeated 6 times in that order: evening and morning - in Genesis 1:5, 8, 13, 19, 23, 31.
- Evening** - Night – Darkness – 12 hours
- Morning** – Day – Light – 12 hours
- Sunset to Sunset** – Levitical Laws of Cleanliness confirm an evening to evening length of day

## Biblical Calendar: Enunciation and Illustration

### Universal Laws Illustrated by Physical Laws

**3.** “And God said, Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night; and let them be for **signs**, and for **seasons**, and for **days**, and **years**.” Genesis 1:14

**Signs – Seasons – Days and Years – Genesis 1:14**

- ❑ **Signs** = Stars - Constellations – Mazzaroth made up of 12 Constellations - Job 38:31, 32
- ❑ “A woman clothed with the **sun**, and the **moon** under her feet, and upon her head a crown of **twelve stars**.” Revelation 12:1
- ❑ **Seasons** = Moon – Month – Feasts – Seasons H4150 “He appointed the moon for seasons.” Psalm 104:19
- ❑ **Days and Years** = Sun to rule the day and the year - sunset to sunset - Moon and stars to rule the night

- ❑ Luni-Solar
- ❑ Barley Harvest
- ❑ New Moon Horned Crescent
- ❑ Common and Embolismic Intercalation
- ❑ Sunset to Sunset

#### 4. Common and Embolismic year

- ❑ **Solar** cycle of **365** days per year  
**Lunar** cycle of **354** days per year  
**Difference:** **11** days between the 2 cycles
- ❑ The difference of 11 days accumulates over time and an additional month is added - **embolismic year** - every 2 or 3 years to make up the difference – it is called **intercalation: 31 AD and 1844** were **embolismic years** - a regular year without intercalation is called a ‘**common year**’
- ❑ **Prophetic year** of 360 days is obtained by adding the 2 cycles and dividing by 2:  
 $365.24 + 354.37 = 719.61 \div 2 = 360$

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**5.** “In the six hundredth **year** of Noah's life, in the second **month**, the seventeenth **day** of the month, the same day were all the fountains of the great deep broken up, and the windows of heaven were opened.” Genesis 7:11

- First verse and Biblical **Synchronism** mentioning the **Year-Month-Day** pattern
- Over one hundred synchronisms (**dated events**) are found in the Bible which can be ascertained with **genealogy** and **chronology** and can only be reckoned with the true Biblical Calendar
- The book of Genesis Chapters 7 and 8 contains **13 synchronisms** ascertained by **genealogy**
- The book of Ezekiel contains **14 synchronisms** ascertained by **chronology**

**6 .** “Their **line** is gone out through all the earth.... He set a tabernacle for the sun.” Psalm 19:4  
“Who hath stretched the **line** upon it?” Job 38:5

- The **ecliptic line** is the path the **sun** takes through the sky as a result of the Earth's revolution around it and represents the extension or projection of the plane of the Earth's orbit out towards the sky.
- Since the **moon** and the **planets** also move in orbits, whose planes do not differ greatly from that of the Earth's orbit, these bodies, when visible in our sky, stay relatively close to the line.
- Twelve Cardinal constellations in their seasons through which the ecliptic line passes, form the **Mazzaroth** of Job 38:32 (Zodiac). The sun travels the ecliptic line from one constellation to another in 1 year and the moon north and south of it in 1 month. The sky is divided astronomically in 88 constellations (12 Cardinals – 76 Decans)

  - A. We need 2 witnesses: the Moon and a Grain
- Q. Which Moon and which Grain?
  - A. Passover Moon - Wave Sheaf Grain for Firstfruits

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### 9. Wave Sheaf at Firstfruits: Barley

“And the flax and the barley was smitten: for the barley was in the ear, and the flax was bollen. But the wheat and the rie were not smitten: for they were not grown up.” Exodus 9:31, 32

“And ye shall reap the harvest thereof, then ye shall bring a sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest unto the priest: And he shall wave the sheaf before the LORD, to be accepted for you: on the morrow after the sabbath the priest shall wave it.” Leviticus 23:10, 11

The **Barley** which was smitten under the 7<sup>th</sup> plague preceded the 10<sup>th</sup> plague at **Passover** on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of the first month according to Exodus 12:6

“**Barley** was the earliest grain in Palestine, and at the opening of the feast it was beginning to ripen. A **sheaf** of this grain was waved by the priest before the altar of God” [Altar of Incense at Firstfruits, First Month - Abib 16]. Patriarchs and Prophets, 539

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### 10. Wave Sheaf at Firstfruits: Barley

- If the barley was not ripen for the Spring Feasts another month was added at the end of the year and the Feasts were celebrated 1 month later that year. The embolismic year was connected with barley.

### 11. New Moon Horned Crescent

- Q. Why the New Moon of the first month has to be the New Moon Horned Crescent?**  
**A.** In order for Passover to be on the **14<sup>th</sup> of the First Month** or Abib 14<sup>th</sup> according to Exodus 12:6; Leviticus 23:5; Numbers 28:16, the New Moon must be the Horned Crescent. Not the Conjunction, nor the First Visible Crescent.

A conjunction new moon will advance Passover by 2 days; a first visible crescent will advance Passover by 1 day and will make it occur on the Full Moon as it happens with the Rabbinical Jew Passover. History confirms that the Passover day was the day following the full Moon at sunset and not on it.

### 12. New Moon Horned Crescent and Passover

“This month shall be unto you the beginning of months: it shall be the first month of the year to you.” Exodus 12:2

- ❑ “If we accept the testimony of Aristobulos, 200 years before Christ -- that the Passover of the Jews followed the sunset of the day when the full moon rising in the east faces the setting sun in the west -- we can reasonably conclude that the Jewish Passover, which is repeatedly described in the Bible as the 14th day of Nisan [Abib] was the **day following the full moon date**, and not on it [or was] the **‘day after the evening when the moon** stands diametrically opposed to the sun, as everyone can see at the time of full moon.”

- ❑ “In company with His disciples, the Saviour slowly made His way to the garden of Gethsemane. The **Passover moon, broad and full**, shone from a cloudless sky. The city of pilgrims’ tents was hushed into silence.”

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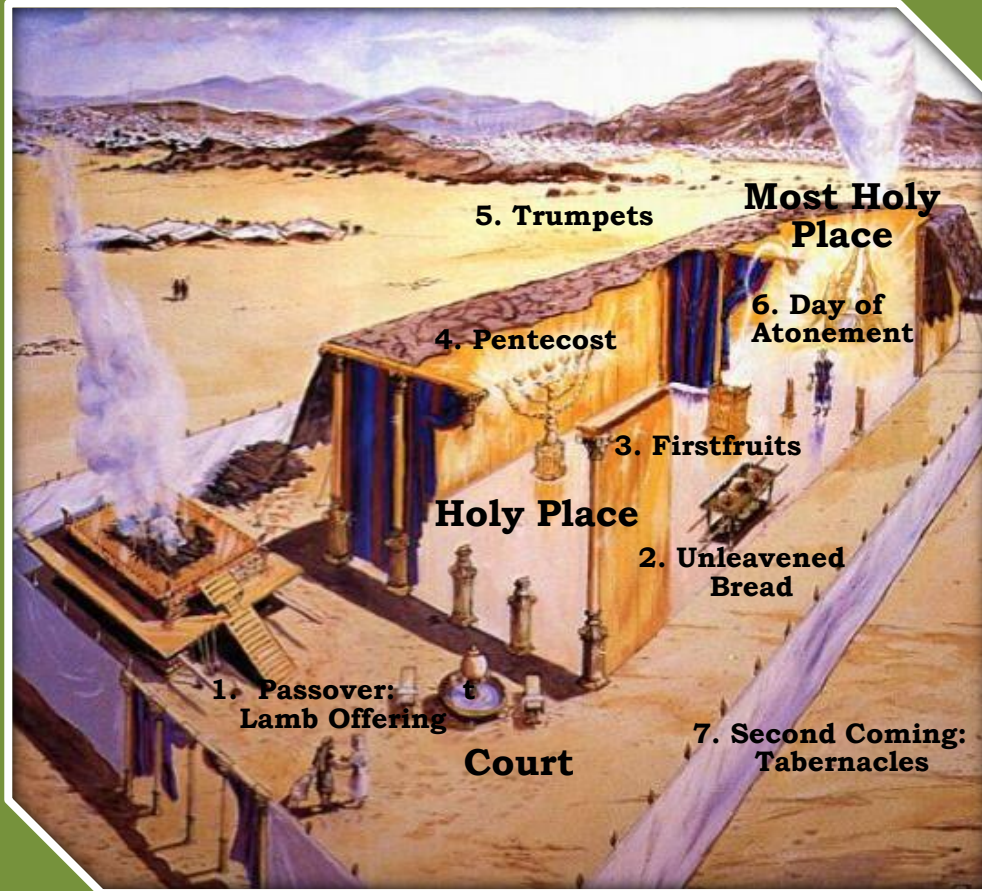

#### 14. Christ's Fulfilment: New Testament Calendar – Leviticus 23

- Fact 1. Christ was selected to die: the 10th day of the first month in 31 AD
- Fact 2. Christ died on: the 14th day
- Fact 3. Christ died at: the hours of evening sacrifice
- Fact 4. Christ died at: the 9<sup>th</sup> hour: 3 - 6 p.m.
- Fact 5. Christ died at: Feast of Passover
- Fact 6. Christ rested on: Feast of Unleavened Bread and a 7<sup>th</sup> day Sabbath
- Fact 7. Christ resurrected at: Firstfruits
- Fact 8. Christ sent the Holy Spirit at: Pentecost
- Fact 9. Christ announced the Judgment through the Millerites at: Trumpets
- Fact 10. Christ entered the Most Holy Place: on the Day of Atonement on October 22<sup>nd</sup> 1844
- Fact 11. Christ is returning at: Tabernacles
